The Turkey Shoot. The Premier social event at AMA is our annual turkey shoot. If you're new to this, you don't actually shoot a turkey. You shoot a paper target that has a picture of a turkey on it. On that target are random numbers that you can't see from 20 yards. Prizes are awarded in order of score. Everyone gets a prize too. The Turkey Shoot is Tuesday, December 9th; 7:00 PM. Spare guns will be onsite for anyone who doesn't have a 22 pistol. This is a great chance to meet other members so don't miss it.

The Annual AMA House League competition commences Thursday January 8th 2015. I welcome back all the previous competitors and especially welcome new participants. The league is in two parts. The first is 6 weeks of standard pistol (.22) followed by 6 weeks of center-fire (32 or 38 SPL or 9MM or 40 S&W). Rules are similar to the International Shooting Sports Federation program and all shooting is done with one hand. Prizes are awarded as first, second & third place as well as high score in some categories and are presented at our Annual General meeting in May. Canadian Shooting Sports Association (CSSA) Indoor Winter Center fire Pistol Postal match.

The CSSA has sponsored a Winter League Postal Match for many years in the Southern Ontario region but this year has opened it up to clubs across Canada (a postal match means results are mailed in, and has nothing to do with "going postal"!). AMA is now a participating club and has already completed the .22 rim fire portion with plans now underway for the center fire event. The beauty of a Postal match is that you can participate in a national competition in the comfort of your own range!

So if you're interested in trying a Bullseye competition, want to improve your marksmanship or just want to have some fun then come out and join us. Dates will be Saturday mornings from 9:30 am to approx. 11:00 am on Jan 17, Feb 21, March 21 and April 11.

The matches to be shot will be very similar to the AMA Center fire House league except they will be a full 60 shot match comprised of 20 shots precision and 40 rounds timed fire. The event is shot one handed with either semi auto pistol or revolver of a 30 caliber handgun (.32, 38, 9mm etc.) with iron sights.

To be eligible for the CSSA awards you will need to be member of the CSSA and complete 3 out of the 4 monthly matches (if more than 3 shot, the top 3 scores are used). Participants will receive an official shooting classification after the 2nd match so you only compete against shooters of your own skill level. There will be a fee of \$7 for each match.

Curious about giving it a try but are reluctant to jump into a formal competition? Then let me know your interest as well, as spots can be made available for participants to shoot the event without having to send in results.
