The Turkey Shoot. The Premier social event at AMA is our annual turkey shoot. If you're new to this, you don't actually shoot a turkey. You shoot a paper target that has a picture of a turkey on it. On that target are random numbers that you can't see from 20 yards. Prizes are awarded in order of score. Everyone gets a prize too. The Turkey Shoot is **Tuesday, December 8th; 6:30 PM.** Spare guns will be onsite for anyone who doesn't have a 22 pistol. This is a great chance to meet other members so don't miss it.

The Annual AMA House League should return in January on Thursday evenings. The league is in two parts. The first is 6 weeks of standard pistol (.22) followed by 6 weeks of center-fire (32 or 38 SPL or 9MM or 40 S&W). Rules are similar to the International Shooting Sports Federation program and all shooting is done with one hand. Prizes are awarded as first, second & third place as well as high score in some categories and are presented at our Annual General meeting in May. Shooting takes place in our downstairs range beginning around 6:15-6:30pm. **The exact start date will be emailed on our email mailing list.**

RENEWALS were due September 30th. We are now checking everyone at the range to make sure that you have renewed. ATTs – After the Conservative government passed the "Common Sense Firearms Licensing Act" that came into force on September 2nd, we no longer need to do ATT forms. Basically; your PAL has become your ATT so long as you keep your membership current. Your PAL allows you to transport your restricted firearms to the range, to a gunsmith and from a store you buy them at. Like the previous ATT, if you get caught with your restricted firearm some place you should not be – you'll still be going to jail. So nothing has really changed except that you carry one less piece of paper and don't have to contact the CFO for extra one-off ATTs.
