**The Turkey Shoot.** The Premier social event at AMA is our annual turkey shoot. If you're new to this, you don't actually shoot a turkey. You shoot a paper target that has a picture of a turkey on it. On that target are random numbers that you can't see from 20 yards. Prizes are awarded in order of score. Everyone gets a prize too.

**This year we're repeating the charity event again;** At the shoot, there will be a box for the **Litters 'N Critters Dog rescue shelter**. If you like, you can bring and donate something in the box and we will give it to the shelter the following day.

- KONGs, the large sized black ones for dogs up to 50 pounds
- Antler Chews
- Durable toys for adult dogs (*no Dollar Store toys as they are not dog safe*)
- Dog Bowls with rubber non slip bottom, either metal or ceramic are great.
- Thick fleecy type throws/small blankets for lining kennels
- Gas gift cards
- Gift cards for Costco, Pet Stores, Walmart or grocery stores. (*We need to get Raw food for some dogs*)
- Coconut Oil, Peroxide, Apple Cider Vinegar, White Vinegar
- Paper Towels, Printing paper, Stamps
- The little flashing hanging lights that clip onto collars or leashes for when people are walking in the dark and it makes the dogs more visible.
- Monetary donations or a donation on their vet account at Carnegie Animal Hospital are always very much appreciated.
